### WHAT'S GOING ON AT HPL?

**HOLIDAY HOURS.** Hackley Library will be open on Veteran's Day, in honor of those who fought for our freedom. The Library will be closed on Nov. 24 for Thanksgiving, and on Dec. 24 and Dec. 26 for Christmas. The library will also be closed on Dec. 31 and Jan. 2 for New Year.
