## WHAT'S GOING ON AT HPL?

**Holiday Hours.** Hackley Library will be open on Veteran's Day Nov. 11, in honor of those who fought for our freedom. The Library will closed on Nov. 23 for Thanksgiving, and on Dec. 23, 24 and Dec. 25 for Christmas, open Dec. 26 through Dec. 29. The library will also be closed on Dec. 30 and Jan. 1 for New Year.

**Snow.** From time to time the Hackley Library closes in the winter months. The Library will close when weather conditions deteriorate to the point where emergency situations prevail, or when vital equipment in the library fails, or when a general emergency has been declared in the City of Muskegon. The Library does not close automatically when Muskegon Schools close. Call the Library, listen to WMUS, or check Channel 13 WZZM or Channel 8 WOOD-TV before setting out if you're not sure.
